BONDING Web only

Current Bonds for Post Quartermaster/Officers will expire August 31, 2026, and Canteen Manger/Employee Bonds will expire September 30, 2026. All Posts should remit the correct amount to Department Headquarters now. Amounts: Quartermaster/Officer \$5.00 per thousand minimum of \$3,000. Club manager and all others \$8.00 per thousand minimum of \$3,000. If you are bonding through an outside agency, please forward proof from company to VFW State Headquarters. These forms will be on the web site at VFWAR.org under Resources, Reports and Forms. District Commanders will be emailed a copy of the forms. The bond applications will not be mailed out this year.

Commanders are reminded that all persons handling post funds, including the Club Manager and Bingo Chairman, shall keep accurate and complete records. Post Trustees shall audit these records in the same manner as Post Quartermaster records.

Remember they get shipped directly from National so it takes up to 1 week to receive (Orders MUST still come through Department Headquarters.) Prices are \$145.00 per 500 for Legacy Poppies and \$90 per 500 for Tin Poppies. There is an increase in this charge when credit cards are used. Please plan your Buddy Poppy Drive now. POW/MIA Flag

POW/MIA Flag – Official Display Days: Public Law 105-85 (November 16, 1997) indicates the days that federal agencies, military installations and U.S. post offices are required to display the POW/MIA flag. The days are Veterans Day, Armed Forces Day, Memorial Day, Flag Day, and National POW/MIA Day.

POST COMMANDERS Notify IRS of Quartermaster Change

In January 2014, the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) began requiring entities with EIN to file IRD Form 8822-B to report the latest change of address or responsible party. Form 8822-B must be filed within 60 days of the change. The purpose of Form 8822-B is to notify the IRS of changes to your business mailing address, location, or the identity of your responsible party. 2026 Annual Report for Nonprofit Corporation PAST DUE

Deadline: August 1, 2026: Just received information from the Secretary of the State office that Posts were waiting for the postcard mail out regarding Annual Nonprofit renewals. It is all online now. Please go to www.sos.arkansas.gov/BCS to file your 2026 report of officers. There is no penalty for being late, but it could hurt the post in the future. Please go online and complete today. REMOVAL OF AN OFFICER

Section 220 of the National By-Laws, "Vacancies and Removal of Elective Officers" states that "Any elective Post Officer removed by the Department Commander, by reason of failure to pay current dues or by vote of the Post under the provisions of this section, shall not be eligible to serve in any Post office in the same administrative year in which the Officer is removed."
