



HOW TO SIGN INTO BTSSS USING ID.ME

1. Go to <https://eauth.va.gov/accessva/>



2. Click on **I AM A VETERAN**
3. Go to **VETERAN TRAVEL CLAIM ENTRY**



4. Click on **SIGN IN WITH ID.ME**
