

# Post All State

1. Post must reach greater than 100% in membership by June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
  - A. To receive hat and other acknowledgements at the State Convention, Membership must be met by April 18, 2023.
  - B. To be recognized at State Convention, 100% must be reached prior to the convening of the 92<sup>nd</sup> State Convention.
2. Number of new, reinstated and/or new/reinstated life members must total (collectively) at least 4% from June 30, 2022 membership).
3. Post must have greater than 50 members by June 30, 2023.
4. Post must not be in arrears to District, Department or National for financial obligations.
5. Post Quartermaster must be sufficiently bonded.
6. Post must have no officer vacancies.
7. Post quarterly audits must be current and received by Department Headquarters no later than April 20, 2023.
8. Post must submit quarterly community service reports to Department Headquarters. (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> quarters due by April 20, 2023)
9. Post must make at least one Buddy Poppy purchase (sold in increments of 500) and conduct a minimum of two (2) Buddy Poppy Drives. Photos must be submitted during year to the Department Facebook page, (VFW Department of Arkansas)
10. Multiple Post members must recruit members. Conduct at least 2 recruiting drives (Post of FaceBook)
11. 100% attendance to District meetings.

11. Post must donate to at least one (1) of the following listed Department funds (Minimum of \$50)
  - Commanders Project (\$50)
  - State Voice of Democracy Scholarship Fund
  - State Unmet Needs Fund
  - State Disaster Relief (Natural Disasters)
12. Post must participate in the following programs:
  - Submit Voice of Democracy entry to District for judging
  - Submit Patriots Pen entry to District for judging
  - 1 Teacher of the Year
  - Special consideration for Scout of the Year
13. Post must make a minimum of \$50 donation to National Veterans & Military Support Services. (Note: minimum of \$100 requirement for All American eligibility)
14. Community Service:
  - A. One (1) Special project above and beyond normal reporting that was preapproved by the Department Commander **OR** may Adopt-a-Unit **OR** one (1) Partnering event (pick one)

NOTE: This year there is **NO** requirement in the All-American Program for a Post or District to make All State in order to be eligible for All American. However, the All State Program is laid out to set each Post/District up for success to ensure they meet the criteria for eligibility for 2022-2023 All American recognition.

# District All State

1. District must create/maintain a FaceBook Page
2. School of Instruction must be conducted at every meeting (reported to state Headquarters).
3. District must reach greater than 100% in membership by June 30, 2023.
  - A. To receive hat and other acknowledgements at State Convention, Membership must be met by April 22, 2023.
  - B. To be recognized at State Convention greater than 100% must be reached prior to the convening of the 92<sup>nd</sup> Annual State Convention.
4. Number of new/reinstated continuous members and new/ reinstated life members must total (collectively) at least 3% from June 30, 2022, membership).
5. District must not be in arrears to Department or National for financial obligations.
6. District Quartermaster must be sufficiently bonded.
7. District quarterly audits must be current and received by Department Headquarters no later than April 20, 2023.
6. Districts must submit one entry (1) for Patriots Pen to Department for judging.
7. Districts must submit one (1) entry for Voice of Democracy to Department for judging.

NOTE: This year there is **NO** requirement in the All-American Program for a Post or District to make All State in order to be eligible for All American.

However, the All State Program is laid out to set each Post/District up for success to ensure they meet the criteria for the 2022-2023 All American recognition.
